### The Skylark's War: by Hilary McKay

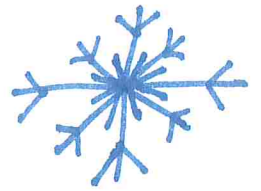
Clarrie and her older brother Peter live for their summers in Cornwall, staying with their grandparents and running free with their charismatic cousin, Rupert.

## Is Father Christmas real?

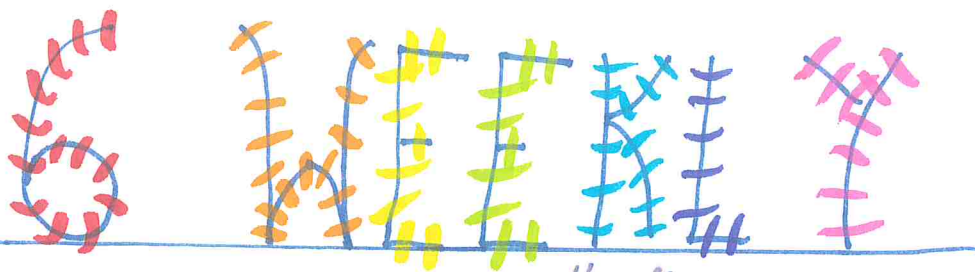


Reasons why he/she is real:

(just finished) Aidrian newey biography.

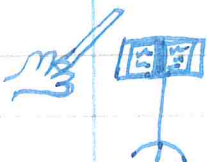
Q4. Your Fav colour?
